Overview

The following calendar outlines the My Forever Family NSW carer recruitment campaigns to be undertaken from July 2023 to June 2024, which supplement the carer recruitment efforts of the sector.

Collateral and messaging for each campaign will be advertised statewide, however there will be particular emphasis on geographical areas dependent on the campaign and location of corresponding information sessions.

Campaigns

- Each campaign will include information sessions in selected districts. These information sessions may be either in-person or online. In-person session venues to be advised closer to the time.
- Each campaign will include content and collateral available for download and sharing, plus a mix of media (broadcast, print, digital or outdoor).
- Select campaigns will include a culturally and linguistically diverse (CALD) focus and/or engagement with local Aboriginal Community Controlled Organisations (ACCOs). These campaigns are specified below.
